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BOOK OF ABSTRACT

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PAN-EUROPEAN TBLT ACTIVITIES AS SUPPORT TO FOREIGN LANGUAGES LEARNING

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Plurilingual Europe with its strong actions supports learning of foreign languages as primary need in achievement of communication and mobility inside of a community.
